

OSHA Regulations 1910.178

OSHA regulations 1910.178 requires that all forklift operators complete a formal instruction class and be evaluated in the workplace.

This training must be done no less than every three years, and must be repeated if the driver has any driving mishaps or near misses.

Training shall consist of a combination of:

- Formal Instruction (lecture, discussion, interactive computer learning, and written material)
- Practical Training (demonstrations and exercises performed by the operator)
- Evaluation of the operator's performance in the workplace.

FORKLIFT 101

This is the basic OSHA Forklift Safety Course. Students participate in a discussion period where safe operation and procedures are reviewed. Once the discussion is completed, students view an OSHA forklift safety video and take a 50 question exam. A passing grade is required to receive the operators forklift safety card.

Once the students have completed the safety training class they will then be required to operate the forklifts at your facility. This operation is part of the OSHA requirement and is designed to make sure the operator knows the specific equipment and attachments of the vehicle. Our classes are site specific, OSHA compliant and designed around your drivers while still offered at competitive prices.

DRIVER EVALUATIONS

OSHA requires that drivers are evaluated on the equipment they operate in addition to the class room safety. Forklift University can provide this service or you can have a qualified supervisor perform the evaluations. The option is completely up to the customer.

DRIVER TRAINING

Many times companies purchase new equipment without having someone in the company that has the experience or training to actually operate the vehicle. In these cases, Forklift University can provide driver training to individuals or groups up to 4 on the physical operations of the companies forklift. These classes typically require from up to 4 hours of hands on operation and are available by appointment only. Cost varies depending on the number of students and the type of equipment used.

TRAIN THE TRAINER

Train the Trainer is a forklift instructor training class. Instructors are trained to find safety issues within your facility, to deal with experienced and new drivers, and updated on the OSHA guidelines as they pertain to forklift operators.

They receive a paper and electronic training guide that has manuals, tests, accident summaries, evaluation forms, certification cards and many more information items. Also included is the forklift safety video and of course they themselves will be certified once they complete the class. Additional training and testing materials and videos are available in Spanish.

Forklift University does not make you purchase additional manuals or tests, you have the ability to print and re-print your materials at any time in any quantities that you need.
